Berger Singerman's Annual Hurricane Season Survey had more than 1.8K respondents.



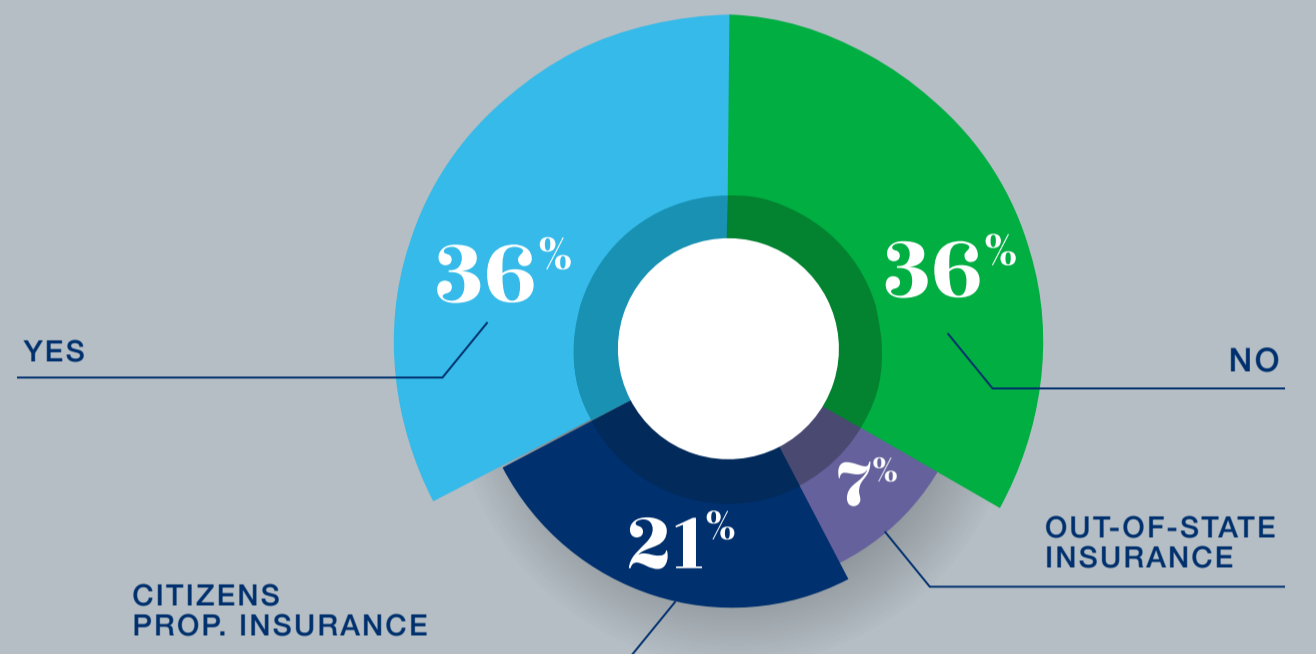
INSURANCE

The majority of respondents claim that their insurance policy has not been cancelled or non-renewed.



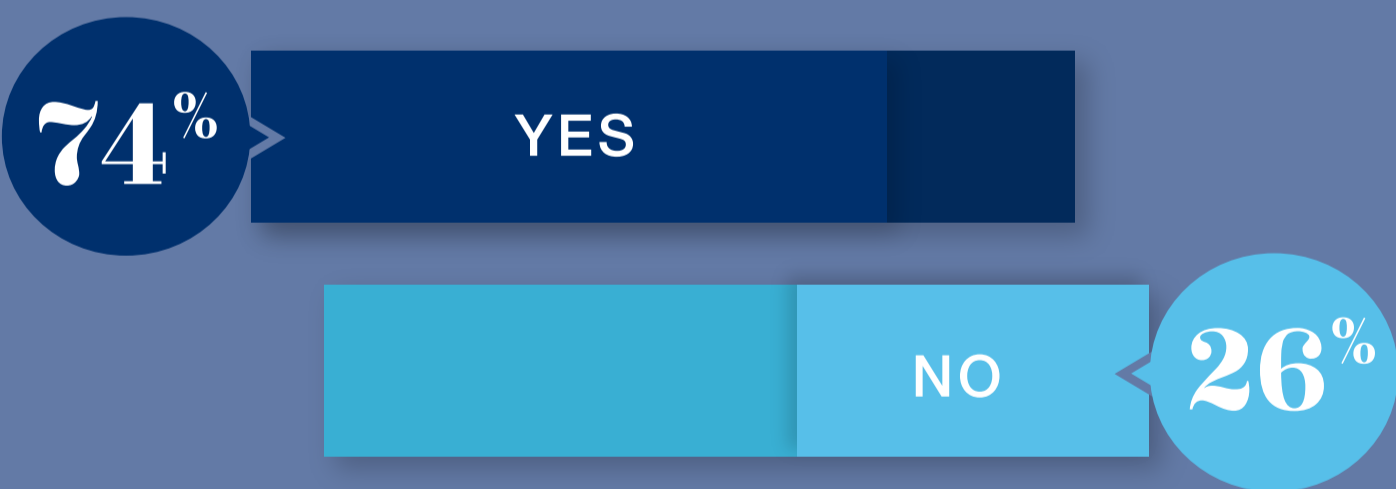
ARE YOU A POLICY HOLDER?

The majority of respondents who were able to find a new insurer after their policy was cancelled or non-renewed, did so through the Citizens Property Insurance Corporation.



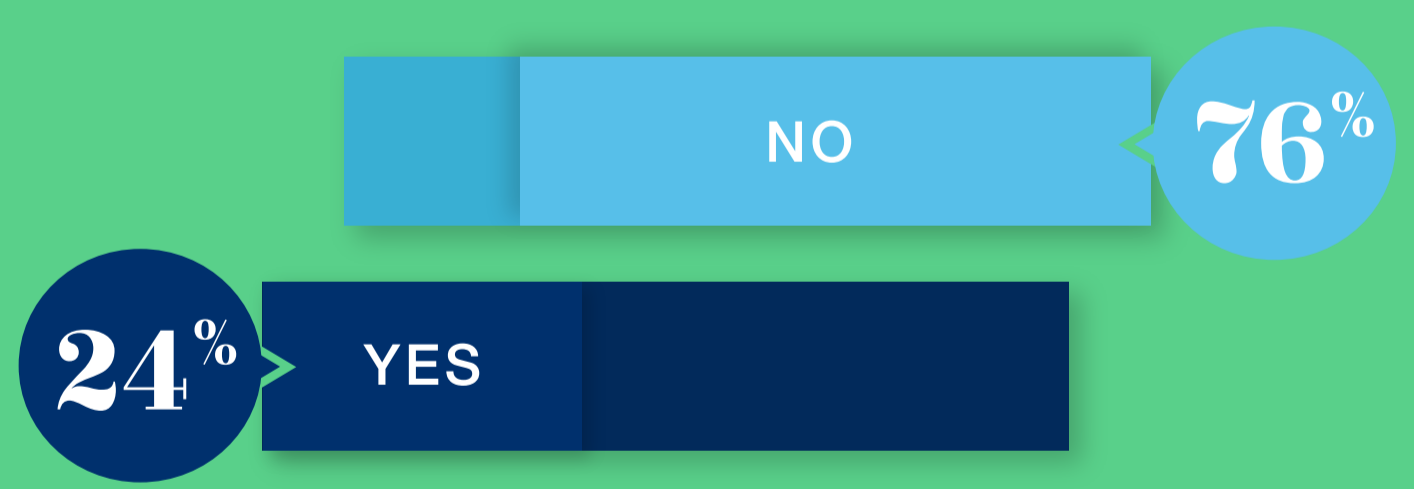
HURRICANE DAMAGES

A vast majority of respondents expect to have the right to file a lawsuit against their insurance company to cover damages.



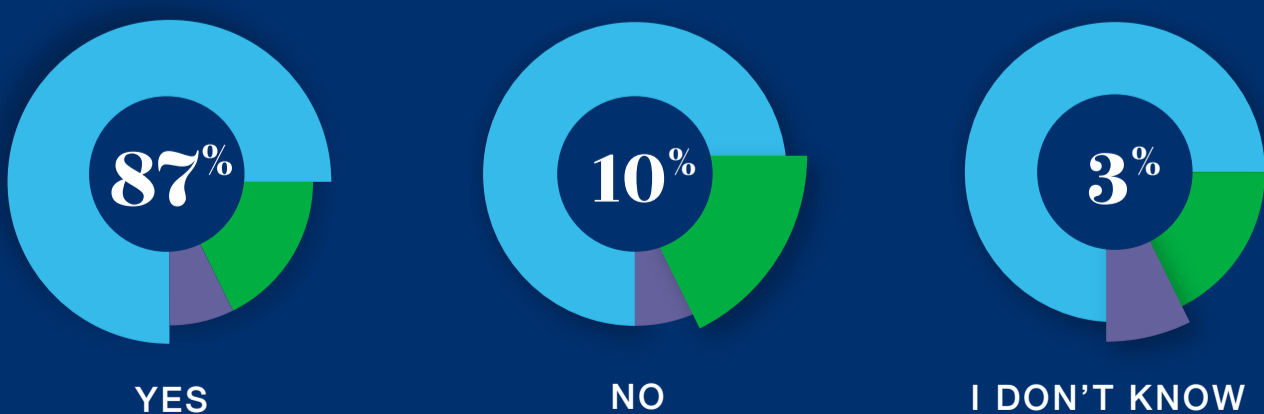
TIME TO MAKE A CLAIM
